## **About material**

### **Decorative plaster MIXART.**

A ready-to-use universal finishing material with an original texture and colour scheme has high performance properties:

- Increased wear resistance;
- Durability;

**Scope:** decorative plaster MIXART is used to create a topcoat on internal and external surfaces: on walls in residential and non-residential premises, bathrooms; on the facades of buildings. The material is applied to surfaces prepared according to the instructions: concrete, gypsum, gypsum plasterboards, stone, cement, brick, chipboard and fibreboard.

## Instructions

### **Surface preparation**



**1.** Clean the base from dirt, wax, oils, grease and other contaminants. Smooth with plasters, fill cracks and small irregularities. The prepared substrate must be dry, even, clean, dust-free and solid white.



- **2.** Treat the prepared surface with deep penetration primer. Dry according to the instructions.
- **3.** Then treat the surface with a special MIXART adhesive primer in 1 layer. Dry according to the instructions. Apply decorative plaster after 24 hours.

⚠We recommend tint the primer to a shade lighter than the selected plaster colour to avoid and reduce material consumption. When tinting, the amount of colorants should not exceed 5% by weight of the primer. We recommend choosing the SILK PLASTER branded colourant.

### **Application**



**4.** Stir the MIXART thoroughly with a drill and mixer head at low speed before application.



**5.** Apply the plaster with a stainless steel trowel with rounded edges, in unidirectional movements, evenly and without gaps.

A Plastering work on one separate surface must be carried out in a continuous way, using the "wet on wet" method.

A If the surface is large, it is necessary to divide it into smaller areas with straight boundaries (lines) made with adhesive plaster tape.

Important: When applying, make sure the paint tools are clean.

⚠ To maintain the specified consumption, maintain a layer thickness of 1 mm over the entire surface.

**Note.** If the packages of material are from different batches and have colour differences, then during preparation it is necessary to mix plaster from different packages with each other in a 1:1 ratio. By mixing new material into the used container every time half of the material remains in the bucket.

Application with a layer of more than 2 mm is not allowed.



**6.** 20 minutes after application, smooth the material with a trapezoidal trowel.

 $\triangle$  The temperature of the air and the surface to be treated must be from + 5°C to + 35°C, the relative humidity of the air must be 65%.

▲To create a smooth surface, sand the material with P40-P80 emery paper after the applied plaster has completely dried (24 hours).

▲Sand it with light strokes, without strong pressure and effort.

**7.** In places with high humidity and high operating stress, cover the plaster with MIXART protective coating.

⚠When wet cleaning, a temporary discolouration of the surface is possible, which will disappear after drying.

### **Mechanised application**

For easy and quick application of MIXART decorative plaster, it is possible to use a cartouche (textured) pneumatic qun with a nozzle diameter of 4 mm.

### **Drying time**

Free modelling time is up to 20 minutes, surface dry to the touch - after 12 hours, complete drying - after 24 hours at a temperature of 20°C and a relative humidity of 65%. At lower temperatures and at higher humidity, the drying time will increase. The final strength gain is in 5-7 days.





# **Mixart 022** (Decorative plaster)




# **Mixart 025** (Decorative plaster)


The sand colour of Mixart 025 decorative plaster is suitable for rooms in a modern style: kitchen, study room, hall and bathrooms.

The tranquil natural shade is perfectly combined with wood and stone textures, soft textiles in muted shades and chrome-coloured metallic décor.











# Mixart 031 (Decorative plaster)

The yellow shade of Mixart 031 plaster will be appropriate in the kitchen, office, corridor or hallway.











# Mixart 029 (Decorative plaster)

The warm shade of the plaster will work well with the rich wood textures of furniture and flooring.










# Mixart 028 (Decorative plaster)

Caramel colour looks good with light pine or oak wood floors, furniture and decor in shades of blue or green.










# **Mixart 036** (Decorative plaster)








## Mixart 033 (Decorative plaster)


# **Mixart 035** (Decorative plaster)



Floors, furniture and decor can be either light grey or white, or almost black, wenge colours, for example.










# **Mixart 027** (Decorative plaster)


The unusual blue colour of Mixart 027 decorative plaster seems to have been created for modern minimalist interiors of living rooms, halls and bathrooms.

Cornflower blue blends harmoniously with light floors in a cool shade, as well as furniture in walnut or smoky oak.










# **Mixart 034** (Decorative plaster)

The rest of the finish should be selected in a light, calm range, for example, pine-coloured floors or cream or beige tiles.









# **Mixart 037** (Decorative plaster)


The rich light green colour of Mixart 037 decorative plaster will refresh and decorate the interior of the kitchen or bathroom, and can also decorate the living room or hallway.

Mixart 037 looks great with light, almost white floors and furniture, as well as textiles in orange or pink-violet colours.










Warm light green shade of Mixart 026 plaster is an excellent solution for connoisseurs of the natural range.


Mixart 021 light decorative plaster will be an excellent choice for decorating walls in corridors, hallways, kitchens or bathrooms.

The style of the room can be any, from minimalism to loft or eclecticism with classic elements.







The noble grey shade of Mixart 038 decorative plaster will look great in almost any interior thanks to its colour and pleasant texture.


Mixart 038 is best combined with floors in neutral or cool colours: parquet in bleached pine, tinted ash or oak, porcelain stoneware in white or grey marble.






